Hon. Riaz Fatyana, MP, Pakistan is the current Chairman of the National Assembly Standing Committee on Law & Justice and Convener of the National Parliamentary Sustainable Development Goals Task Force. He is also a member of the Public Account Committee, National Assembly Standing Committee on Finance, National Assembly Business Advisory Committee, National Counter Terrorism Authority and Special Committee on Agriculture.

Hon. Fatyana has served three terms as a Minister for Education, Finance, Information and Culture in the Government of the Punjab. During his political career, he was elected as Member of the Punjab Provincial Assembly for the terms 1988-1990, 1990-1993 and 1993-1996. He was also a Chairman of National Assembly Standing Committee on Human Rights as well as Parliamentarians Commission for Human Rights from 2003 till 2016.

Hon. Fatyana is a former member of Parliamentarians for Global Action (PGA) and Commonwealth Parliamentary Association (CPA).

Hon. Riaz Fatyana started his career as a member of the Provincial Assembly of the Punjab on a ticket from Muslim League (N). Later he was elected a Member of National Assembly on a ticket of Pakistan Muslim League (Q) from Toba Tek Singh District. In January 2015 Hon. Fatyana joined the Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) political party.

He has served as President of the Pakistan Psychologists Association and Senior Deputy Chief Commissioner of Pakistan Boy Scouts Association. He also served as Central President of the Muslim Students Federation (MSF) and President of the Students Union, Govt. P.S.T College, Kamalia.

Hon. Fatyana obtained his Bachelor of Arts Honors (Political Science) and M.Sc. Applied Psychology degrees from University of the Punjab in 1979 and 1983 respectively, followed by a Bachelor of Law degree from University of Sindh in 1985. Hon. Fatyana holds a National Certificate of Counseling, Ayr College, Scotland, United Kingdom.
