NDC Statement

- **Pakistan's NDC intends to reduce up to 20% of its 2030 projected GHG emissions.**
- **This is subject to the availability of international grants to meet the total abatement cost of about US\$ 40 billion for mitigation and US\$ 7-14 billion for Adaptation per annum at current prices**


Recommendation from Standing Committee on Climate Changes for 2nd NDC

- Concerned government Departments may identify new sectors that were missed in the first NDC by Pakistan. These sectors are: inclusion of Youth, health prioritisation, blue carbon.
- Revised NDC should include a cross-sectoral ‘whole-of-government’ approach to revise, review, and report on climate action.
- REhance institutional arrangements and governance approaches, increasing participation of state, and non-state actors (such as development partners, UN agencies, private sector) as part of a ‘whole-of-society’ approach.




