Glynda is a lawyer with an environmental management degree and more than 16 years' experience in air quality management. She is the Deputy Executive Director of Clean Air Asia, an international non-governmental organization leading the regional mission for better air quality, and healthier, more livable cities throughout Asia. Clean Air Asia works with partners to reduce air pollution and greenhouse gas emissions across Asia by building capacity, advocating for effective and appropriate policies and practice, and informing stakeholders of air pollution and climate change impacts. As Deputy Executive Director, she sets the strategic direction for these Clean Air Asia programs: Air Quality and Climate Change, Sustainable Transport (Low Emissions Urban Development, Clean Fuels and Vehicles, and Green Freight), and Cities for Clean Air Certification.

As former Partnership and Policy Manager of Clean Air Asia, she led the implementation of the *Asia Clean Fuels and Vehicles Project* which assisted countries in developing policies to improve fuel quality and vehicle emissions, the most significant being the Vietnam and Philippine regulations mandating Euro 4 vehicle emission and fuel standards. She actively worked with cities in Asia and spearheaded efforts in partnership building, knowledge sharing, project development and implementation such as: development of science-based clean air plans under the *ASEAN-GIZ Clean Air for Smaller Cities in the ASEAN Region*; and the *Low Emissions Cities for Energy and Transport Project* which developed and piloted a rapid assessment tool to estimate city emissions from transport and building energy use in the Philippines, Sri Lanka and Vietnam. Glynda also helped steer projects implemented jointly by Clean Air Asia with its offices and country networks in China, India, Indonesia, Nepal, Pakistan, Philippines, Sri Lanka and Vietnam.

Prior to joining Clean Air Asia, she assisted the Philippine Government in drafting the Implementing Rules and Regulations of the Philippine Clean Air Act of 1999 as part of a core group of lawyers. Glynda holds a Master's degree in Environmental Management from a joint program of the Ateneo de Manila University and University of San Francisco; a Bachelor of Laws from the University of the Philippines; and a Bachelor of Science in Commerce major in Accounting (graduated Summa Cum Laude) from the University of San Carlos, Cebu, Philippines.
